



1. Ensure that swimmers arrive and are collected at the end of their designated session promptly.
2. Ensure swimmers arrive suitably equipped - see squad expectations.
3. Ensure that swimmers are entered into all targeted meets. All entries to be decided in discussion with swimmer/coach. Parents are asked not to decide which events a swimmer should enter.
4. Ensure the swimmer is aware of various club policies as distributed to you.
5. Advise the coach in advance of any non-attendance at competitions and long course training.
6. Advise the Coach if swimmers are going to miss a session due to school commitments, illness, injury etc.
7. Support **ALL** Coaching staff, venue staff and the swim program in place.
8. Do not interrupt the coach or attempt to communicate with a swimmer whilst a coaching session is in progress.
9. When needing to speak to a coach, do so at a convenient moment prior to or after a training session.
10. Do not dispute an officiating decision or result at a competition.
11. Do not 'coach' your swimmer how to race, or how to train. Leave this to the coaching staff.
12. Parents are asked not to give their swimmers extra coaching sessions outside of Swim Gwynedd/home club sessions.
13. Actively support the Swim Gwynedd committee in their efforts to ensure the smooth running of the squad.
14. Regularly check e-mails, notice boards, website for up to date information.
15. Ensure that membership fees, training fees, competition entry fees and any other expenses are kept up to date to help the treasurer balance the club accounts.
16. Ensure that the membership secretary always has up to date information and contact details.
17. Actively support ALL our swimmers in competition.
18. Adhere to the Swim Wales/Swim Gwynedd Code of conduct at all times.
